

The Patriarch Dispensations Knowledge Of God

Romans 1:21 because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened

Romans 1:28 And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting;

Romans 1:25 who exchanged the truth of God for the lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever. Amen.

I. God Spoke Directly To The Patriarchs

Genesis 3:9 Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?"

Genesis 6:13 And God said to Noah, "The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is filled with violence through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

2 Peter 2:5-6 and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly;

Genesis 12:1 Now the LORD had said to Abram: "Get out of your country, From your family And from your father's house, To a land that I will show you.

Genesis 26:5 because Abraham obeyed My voice and kept My charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws.

Job 23:11-12 My foot has held fast to His steps; I have kept His way and not turned aside. 12 I have not departed from the commandment of His lips; I have treasured the words of His mouth More than my necessary food.

Job 15:9-10 What do you know that we do not know? What do you understand that is not in us? 10 Both the gray-haired and the aged are among us, Much older than your father.

Job 15:18 What wise men have told, Not hiding anything received from their fathers,

VI. The Patriarchs Knowledge About Service To God

Job 28:28 And to man He said, 'Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, And to depart from evil is understanding.'"

Job 21:14-15 Yet they say to God, 'Depart from us, For we do not desire the knowledge of Your ways. 15 Who is the Almighty, that we should serve Him? And what profit do we have if we pray to Him?'

VII. The Patriarchs Knowledge About Good And Evil

Job 13:23 How many are my iniquities and sins? Make me know my transgression and my sin.

Job 24:14-15 The murderer rises with the light; He kills the poor and needy; And in the night he is like a thief. 15 The eye of the adulterer waits for the twilight, Saying, 'No eye will see me'; And he disguises his face.

Job 31:5 "If I have walked with falsehood, Or if my foot has hastened to deceit,

Job 31:9 "If my heart has been enticed by a woman, Or if I have lurked at my neighbor's door

Job 31:24 If I have made gold my hope, Or said to fine gold, 'You are my confidence';

Job 31:26-28 If I have observed the sun when it shines, Or the moon moving in brightness, 27 So that my heart has been secretly enticed, And my mouth has kissed my hand; 28 This also would be an iniquity deserving of judgment, For I would have denied God who is above.

Job 31:1 "I have made a covenant with my eyes; Why then should I look upon a young woman?

Job 31:29 "If I have rejoiced at the destruction of him who hated me, Or lifted myself up when evil found him

VIII. The Patriarchs Knowledge Of How To Deal With Sin

Job 42:8 Now therefore, take for yourselves seven bulls and seven rams, go to My servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and My servant Job shall pray for you. For I will accept him, lest I deal with you according to your folly; because you have not spoken of Me what is right, as My servant Job has."

Job 1:5 So it was, when the days of feasting had run their course, that Job would send and sanctify them, and he would rise early in the morning and offer burnt offerings according to the number of them all. For Job said, "It may be that my sons have sinned and cursed God in their hearts." Thus Job did regularly.

IX. The Separation Of Israel From The Gentiles By The Covenant

Exodus 34:27 Then the LORD said to Moses, "Write these words, for according to the tenor of these words I have made a covenant with you and with Israel."
