## What Will You Leave Behind You When You Leave This Life?

Proverbs 20:7 The righteous man walks in his integrity; His children are blessed after him.

Proverbs 13:22 A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children, But the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.

I. Will You Leave Wisdom Behind You In The Minds Of Those Who Knew You?

Proverbs 13:20 <u>He who walks with wise men will be wise</u>, But the companion of fools will be destroyed.

Ezekiel 16:44 "Like mother, like daughter."

Proverbs 4:10-13 <u>Hear, my son, and receive my sayings</u>, And the years of your life will be many. 11 <u>I</u> <u>have taught you in the way of wisdom</u>; <u>I have led you in right paths</u>. 12 When you walk, your steps will not be hindered, And when you run, you will not stumble. 13 <u>Take firm hold of instruction</u>, <u>do not let go. Keep her, for she is your life</u>.

Proverbs 1:8-9 My son, hear the instruction of your father, And do not forsake the law of your mother; 9 For they will be a graceful ornament on your head, And chains about your neck.

Proverbs 3:1-2 My son, do not forget my law, But let your heart keep my commands; 2 For length of days and long life And peace they will add to you.

Proverbs 22:6 Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.

II. Will You Leave Truth And Faith In The Hearts Of Those Who Knew You?

2 Peter 1:12-15 For this reason I will not be negligent to remind you always of these things, though you know and are established in the present truth.13 Yes, I think it is right, as long as I am in this tent, to stir you up by reminding you,14 knowing that shortly I must put off my tent, just as our Lord Jesus Christ showed me.15 Moreover I will be careful to ensure that you always have a reminder of these things after my decease.

Joel 1:3 <u>Tell your children about it</u>, <u>Let your children tell their children</u>, <u>And their children another</u> generation.

- 2 Timothy 3:15 and that <u>from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures</u>, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
- 2 Timothy 1:5 when I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.

Timothy 2:1-2 You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus.2 And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.

## III. Will You Leave Hope In The Hearts Of Those Who Knew You?

1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 But I do not want you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning those who have fallen asleep, lest you sorrow as others who have no hope.14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so God will bring with Him those who sleep in Jesus. 15 For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep.16 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.

## IV. Will You Leave Love In The Hearts Of Those Who Knew You?

Acts 9:36-40 At Joppa there was a certain disciple named Tabitha, which is translated <u>Dorcas. This</u> woman was full of good works and charitable deeds which she did.37 But it happened in those days that she became sick and died. When they had washed her, they laid her in an upper room.38 And since Lydda was near Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent two men to him, imploring him not to delay in coming to them.39 Then Peter arose and went with them. When he had come, they brought him to the upper room. <u>And all the widows stood by him weeping, showing</u> the tunics and garments which Dorcas had made while she was with them.

Proverbs 31:26-31 She opens her mouth with wisdom, And on her tongue is the law of kindness. 27 She watches over the ways of her household, And does not eat the bread of idleness. 28 Her children rise up and call her blessed; Her husband also, and he praises her: 29 "Many daughters have done well, But you excel them all." 30 Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised. 31 Give her of the fruit of her hands, And let her own works praise her in the gates.

Proverbs 17:6 Children's children are the crown of old men, And the glory of children is their father.

Acts 20:36-38 And when he had said these things, he knelt down and prayed with them all.37 Then they all wept freely, and fell on Paul's neck and kissed him,38 sorrowing most of all for the words which he spoke, that they would see his face no more. And they accompanied him to the ship
