### When Sin Lies At The Door

# 1. The Progression Of Sin From Lying At The Door To Ruling Over You

Genesis 4:6-7 So the Lord said to Cain, "Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen? If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire is for you, but you should rule over it."

Ephesians 4:26-27 "Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil.

Romans 6:12 Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.

Romans 6:6 knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin.

## II. Sin Coming In Through Our Desires

James 1:13-15 Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death.

1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

### A. The Lust Of The Flesh

Psalms 101:3 I will set nothing wicked before my eyes; I hate the work of those who fall away; It shall not cling to me.

Proverbs 4:23 Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life.

#### B. The Lust Of The Eyes

1 Timothy 6:9-10 But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition. For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

#### C. The Pride Of Life

Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall.

# III. Jesus Knocking At The Door

Revelation 3:20 Behold, <u>I stand at the door and knock</u>. <u>If anyone hears My voice and opens the door</u>, <u>I will come in to him and dine with him</u>, and he with Me.

John 14:23 Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.

Ephesians 3:17 that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but <u>Christ lives</u> in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Romans 6:17-20 But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, <u>yet you obeyed</u> from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered. And having been set free from sin, <u>you became slaves of righteousness</u>. I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves of <u>uncleanness</u>, and of <u>lawlessness leading to more lawlessness</u>, so now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness. For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness.

1 John 2:14 I have written to you, young men, Because you are strong, and the word of God abides in you, And you have overcome the wicked one.
