#### What Do I Still Lack?-Christian Growth

Matthew 19:20 The young man said to Him, "All these things I have kept from my youth. What do I still lack?"

2 Peter 1:5-9 But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, 6 to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, 7 to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. 8 For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 9 For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins.

#### I. Do You Lack Faith?

Matthew 14:31 And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"

Mark 9:24 Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!"

Hebrews 3:12 Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God;

Romans 10:17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

### II. Do I Lack Virtue?

John 12:42-43 Nevertheless even among the rulers many believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they did not confess Him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue; 43 for they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God.

1 Corinthians 16:13-14 Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong. 14 Let all that you do be done with love.

Proverbs 28:1 The wicked flee when no one pursues, But the righteous are bold as a lion.

### III. Do I Lack Knowledge?

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have ejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.

Romans 10:22 For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge.

1 Peter 2:2 as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby,

# IV. <u>Do I Lack Self-Control?</u>

Proverbs 4:23 Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life.

James 1:19 So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath;

1 Corinthians 9:27 <u>But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection</u>, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.

### V. <u>Do I Lack Perseverance?</u>

Hebrews 10:36 For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise:

Galatians 6:9 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

#### VI. <u>Do I Lack Godliness?</u>

Hebrews 12:28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, <u>let us</u> have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear.

Proverbs 14:2 <u>He who walks in his uprightness fears the LORD</u>, But he who is perverse in his ways despises Him.

# VII. Do I Lack Brotherly Kindness?

1 Peter 3:8 Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous;

Romans 12:10 Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;

# VIII. Do I Lack Love?

Colossians 3:14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

1 Peter 4:8 And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins.

Philippians 1:9 And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment,
