

Helpers-A Wife Helping Her Husband

Genesis 2:18 And the LORD God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him."

Ephesians 5:31 "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh."

I. A Wife Helping Her Husband Spiritually

1 Corinthians 7:16 For how do you know, O wife, whether you will save your husband? Or how do you know, O husband, whether you will save your wife?

1 Peter 3:1-2 Wives, likewise, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives, 2 when they observe your chaste conduct accompanied by fear.

Proverbs 31:30 Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised.

1 Corinthians 7:2-6 Nevertheless, because of sexual immorality, let each man have his own wife, and let each woman have her own husband. 3 Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband. 4 The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. And likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does. 5 Do not deprive one another except with consent for a time, that you may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again so that Satan does not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

Proverbs 5:19 As a loving deer and a graceful doe, Let her breasts satisfy you at all times; And always be enraptured with her love.

Proverbs 31:22 She makes tapestry for herself; Her clothing is fine linen and purple.

II. A Wife Helping Her Husband By Being Faithful To Him

Proverbs 31:11-12 The heart of her husband safely trusts her; So he will have no lack of gain. 12 She does him good and not evil All the days of her life.

Proverbs 12:4 An excellent wife is the crown of her husband, But she who causes shame is like rottenness in his bones.

III. A Wife Helping Her Husband By Honoring Him

Ephesians 5:33 Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.

Proverbs 27:15 A continual dripping on a very rainy day And a contentious woman are alike;

Proverbs 21:19 Better to dwell in the wilderness, Than with a contentious and angry woman.

Proverbs 14:17 A quick-tempered man acts foolishly, And a man of wicked intentions is hated.

Proverbs 27:4 Wrath is cruel, and anger is outrageous; but who is able to stand before envy?

Proverbs 31:26 She opens her mouth with wisdom, And on her tongue is the law of kindness.

Colossians 4:6 Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.

IV. Helping Your Husband By Being His True Friend

V. Helping Your Husband By Loving And Helping Your Family

Titus 2:4-5 that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, 5 to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.

1 Corinthians 13:4-6 Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; 5 does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil;

Proverbs 31:13-15 She seeks wool and flax, And willingly works with her hands. 14 She is like the merchant ships, She brings her food from afar. 15 She also rises while it is yet night, And provides food for her household, And a portion for her maidservants.

Proverbs 31:21 She is not afraid of snow for her household, For all her household is clothed with scarlet.

Proverbs 31:27 She watches over the ways of her household, And does not eat the bread of idleness.

Proverbs 31:16 She considers a field and buys it; From her profits she plants a vineyard.

Proverbs 31:24 She makes linen garments and sells them, And supplies sashes for the merchants.
