God Haters

Romans 1:30 backbiters, <u>haters of God</u>, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,

Psalm 81:15 <u>The haters of the LORD</u> would pretend submission to Him, But their fate would endure forever.

Without God

Psalm 14:1 The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, They have done abominable works, There is none who does good.

2 Chronicles 15:3 for a long time Israel has been without the true God, without a teaching priest, and without law;

Ephesians 2:12 that at that time you were <u>without Christ</u>, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope and <u>without God in the world</u>.

Psalms 10:4 The wicked in <u>his proud countenance</u> does not seek God; God is in none of his thoughts.

Ungodly

Psalm 1:5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

Deuteronomy 13:4 <u>You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear Him, and keep His commandments and obey His voice</u>; you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: <u>Fear God</u> and <u>keep His commandments</u>, For this is man's all.
