Counting The Cost

Luke 14:28 For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and <u>count the</u> <u>cost, whether he has enough to finish it</u> — 29 lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see it begin to mock him, 30 saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.'

I. <u>The Cost Of Giving The Free Gift</u>

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but <u>the gift of God is eternal life</u> in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 5:15 But <u>the free gift</u> is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.

Philippians 2:5-8 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 <u>who, being in the</u> form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and <u>coming in the likeness of men</u>. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, <u>He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death</u>, even the death of the cross.

John 10:17-18 "Therefore My Father loves Me, because <u>I lay down My life</u> that I may take it again. 18 <u>No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself</u>. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."

John 19:1 So then Pilate took Jesus and scourged Him.

Psalm 22:14-15 <u>I am poured out like water</u>, And <u>all My bones are out of joint</u>; <u>My heart is like</u> <u>wax</u>; <u>It has melted within Me</u>. 15 <u>My strength is dried up like a potsherd</u>, And <u>My tongue clings</u> <u>to My jaws</u>; <u>You have brought Me to the dust of death</u>.

II. <u>The Cost Of Taking The Free Gift</u>

Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you <u>present your</u> bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, <u>which is your reasonable service.</u>

Matthew 10:37-39 <u>He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me.</u> And <u>he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me</u>. 38 And <u>he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me</u>. 39 He who finds his life will lose it, and he who loses his life for My sake will find it.

Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, <u>let him</u> <u>deny himself</u>, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

Matthew 5:10-11 <u>Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake</u>, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 "Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake.

Luke 14:33 So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple.

Matthew 6:24 "<u>No one can serve two masters</u>; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. <u>You cannot serve God and mammon</u>.

Galatians 2:20 <u>I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me</u>; and the life which I now live in the flesh <u>I live by faith in the Son of God</u>, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Romans 6:6 knowing this, that <u>our old man was crucified with Him</u>, that the body of sin might be done away with, <u>that we should no longer be slaves of sin</u>.

III. <u>The Cost Of Rejecting The Free Gift</u>

Romans 6:16 Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that <u>one's slaves whom you obey</u>, whether of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness?

Romans 6:19-23 I speak in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as <u>you</u> <u>presented your members as slaves of uncleanness</u>, and of <u>lawlessness leading to more lawlessness</u>, so <u>now present your members as slaves of righteousness for holiness</u>. 20 For when <u>you were</u> <u>slaves of sin</u>, you were free in regard to righteousness. 21 What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. 22 But now having been set free from sin, and <u>having become slaves of God</u>, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life. 23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

1 John 3:10 In this <u>the children of God</u> and <u>the children of the devil</u> are manifest: <u>Whoever does</u> <u>not practice righteousness is not of God</u>, nor is he who does not love his brother.

2 Timothy 2:25-26 in humility correcting <u>those who are in opposition</u>, if God perhaps will grant them repentance, so that they may know the truth, 26 and that they may come to their senses and <u>escape the snare of the devil, having been taken captive by him to do his will</u>.

Proverbs 13:15 Good understanding gains favor, But the way of the unfaithful is hard.

Hebrews 10:26-27 For <u>if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth</u>, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, 27 but <u>a certain fearful expectation of judgment</u>, and fiery <u>indignation which will devour the adversaries</u>.

Matthew 25:41 "Then He will also say to those on the left hand, <u>'Depart from Me, you cursed,</u> <u>into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels</u>:
