Exodus 16:4 Then the LORD said to Moses, "Behold, I will rain bread from heaven for you. And the people shall go out and gather a certain quota every day, that I may test them, whether they will walk in My law or not.

Exodus 16:16 This is the thing which the LORD has commanded: 'Let every man gather it according to each one's need, one omer for each person, according to the number of persons; let every man take for those who are in his tent." '

Exodus 16:21 So they gathered it every morning, every man according to his need. And when the sun became hot, it melted.

Have The Humility To Glean Food To Survive

Ecclesiastes 6:7 <u>All the labor of man is for his mouth</u>, And yet the soul is not satisfied.

Leviticus 19:9-10 When you reap the harvest of your land, <u>you shall not wholly reap the</u> <u>corners of your field</u>, <u>nor shall you gather the gleanings of your harvest</u>. And you shall not glean your vineyard, nor shall you gather every grape of your vineyard; <u>you shall leave</u> <u>them for the poor and the stranger</u>: I am the LORD your God.

Deuteronomy 24:19-20 "<u>When you reap your harvest in your field, and forget a sheaf in the field, you shall not go back to get it; it shall be for the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, that the LORD your God may bless you in all the work of your hands.</u>

Ruth 2:15-17 And <u>when she rose up to glean</u>, Boaz commanded his young men, saying, "<u>Let</u> <u>her glean even among the sheaves</u>, and do not reproach her. Also <u>let grain from the bundles</u> <u>fall purposely for her</u>; <u>leave it that she may glean</u>, and do not rebuke her." <u>So she gleaned</u> <u>in the field until evening</u>, and beat out what she had gleaned, and it was about an ephah of <u>barley</u>.

Having The Wisdom To Gather In The Harvest While You Can

Proverbs 6:6-11 <u>Go to the ant, you sluggard</u>! <u>Consider her ways and be wise</u>, Which, having no captain, Overseer or ruler, <u>Provides her supplies in the summer, And gathers</u> <u>her food in the harvest</u>. How long will you slumber, O sluggard? When will you rise from your sleep? A little sleep, a little slumber, A little folding of the hands to sleep— So shall your poverty come on you like a prowler, And your need like an armed man.

Proverbs 10:5 He who gathers in summer is a wise son; He who sleeps in harvest is a son who causes shame.

Proverbs 19:24 A lazy man buries his hand in the bowl, And will not so much as bring it to his mouth again.

Ephesians 5:15-16 <u>See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise,</u> <u>redeeming the time</u>, because the days are evil.

2 Kings 6:5-7 But as one was cutting down a tree, the iron ax head fell into the water; and he cried out and said, "Alas, master! For it was borrowed."

Matthew 9:37-38 Then He said to His disciples, "<u>The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."</u>

Luke 10:1-2 After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. Then He said to them, <u>"The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the</u> Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest.

Galatians 6:9 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for <u>in due season we shall reap</u> <u>if we do not lose heart.</u>
