The Kingdom Of Heaven Is Like

I. <u>The Parable Of The Wheat And The Tares</u>

Matthew 13:24-30 Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "<u>The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field</u>; 25 but while men slept, <u>his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way</u>. 26 But <u>when the grain had sprouted and produced a crop, then the tares also appeared</u>. 27 So the servants of the owner came and said to him, 'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have tares?' 28 He said to them, 'An enemy has done this.' The servants said to him, 'Do you want us then to go and gather them up?' 29 But he said, 'No, lest while you gather up the tares you also uproot the wheat with them. 30 Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, "First gather together the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat into my barn."'

Matthew 13:37-43 He answered and said to them: "<u>He who sows the good seed is the Son of Man.</u> 38 <u>The field is the world</u>, <u>the good seeds are the sons of the kingdom</u>, but <u>the tares are the sons of the wicked one</u>. 39 The enemy who sowed them is the devil, <u>the harvest is the end of the age</u>, and the reapers are the angels. 40 Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age. 41 The Son of Man will send out His angels, and <u>they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness</u>, 42 and will cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth. 43 Then the righteous will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears to hear, let him hear!

Matthew 7:21-23 "<u>Not everyone who says to Me,'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven</u>, <u>but he who does the will of My Father in heaven</u>. 22 Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' 23 And then I will declare to them, <u>'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness</u>!'

Matthew 15:13-14 But He answered and said, "<u>Every plant which My heavenly</u> <u>Father has not planted will be uprooted</u>. 14 Let them alone. They are blind leaders of the blind. And if the blind leads the blind, both will fall into a ditch."

II. <u>The Parable Of The Mustard Seed</u>

Matthew 13:31-32 Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "<u>The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed</u>, which a man took and sowed in his field, 32 which indeed is the least of all the seeds; but when it is grown it is greater than the herbs and becomes a tree, so that the birds of the air come and nest in its branches."

III. <u>The Parable Of The Leaven</u>

Matthew 13:33 Another parable He spoke to them: "<u>The kingdom of heaven is like</u> <u>leaven</u>, which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all <u>leavened</u>."

IV. The Parable Of The Hidden Treasure

Matthew 13:44 "Again, <u>the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field</u>, which a man found and hid; and for joy over it he goes and sells all that he has and <u>buys that field</u>.

V. <u>The Parable Of The Pearl Of Great Price</u>

Matthew 13:45-46 "Again, <u>the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking</u> <u>beautiful pearls</u>, 46 who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had and bought it.

Luke 14:33 <u>So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be</u> <u>My disciple</u>.

VI. <u>The Parable Of The Dragnet</u>

Matthew 13:47-50 "Again, <u>the kingdom of heaven is like a dragnet that was cast</u> <u>into the sea and gathered some of every kind</u>, 48 which, when it was full, they drew to shore; and they sat down and gathered the good into vessels, but threw the bad away. 49 So it will be at the end of the age. <u>The angels will come forth</u>, <u>separate the wicked from among the just</u>, 50 and cast them into the furnace of fire. There will be wailing and gnashing of teeth."

Hebrews 4:12 <u>For the word of God is living and powerful</u>, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is <u>a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart</u>.
