The Lost Sheep And The Lost Coin

Luke 15:3-7 So He spoke this parable to them, saying: 4 "What man of you, having a hundred sheep, if he loses one of them, does not leave the ninety-nine in the wilderness, and go after the one which is lost until he finds it? 5 And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing. 6 And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep which was lost!' 7 I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.

Luke 15:8-10 "Or what woman, having ten silver coins, <u>if she loses one coin, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it?</u> 9 And when she has found it, she calls her friends and neighbors together, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the piece which I lost!' 10 Likewise, I say to you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

2 Peter 2:20-22 For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning. 21 For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered to them. 22 But it has happened to them according to the true proverb: "A dog returns to his own vomit," and, "a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire."

The Proper Work Of The Shepherds Of Israel

Ezekiel 34:2-5 Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel, prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD to the shepherds: "Woe to the shepherds of Israel who feed themselves! Should not the shepherds feed the flocks? You eat the fat and clothe yourselves with the wool; you slaughter the fatlings, but you do not feed the flock. The weak you have not strengthened, nor have you healed those who were sick, nor bound up the broken, nor brought back what was driven away, nor sought what was lost; but with force and cruelty you have ruled them. So they were scattered because there was no shepherd; and they became food for all the beasts of the field when they were scattered.

1 Peter 5:2 <u>Shepherd the flock of God which is among you, serving as overseers</u>, not by compulsion but willingly, not for dishonest gain but eagerly;

Hebrews 13:17 Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, <u>for they watch out for your souls</u>, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you.

Matthew 18:12 "What do you think? If a man has a hundred sheep, and one of them goes astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine and go to the mountains to seek the one that is straying?

Luke 15:5 And when he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, rejoicing.

Romans 12:8 he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness.

James 5:19-20 <u>Brethren</u>, <u>if anyone among you wanders from the truth</u>, and <u>someone turns him back</u>, 20 <u>let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.</u>

1 Thessalonians 5:14 Now we exhort you, <u>brethren</u>, <u>warn those who are unruly</u>, <u>comfort the fainthearted</u>, <u>uphold the weak</u>, <u>be patient with all</u>.

Hebrews 3:12-13 <u>Beware, brethren</u>, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; <u>but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be</u> hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 <u>Two are better than one</u>, Because they have a good reward for their labor. 10 For <u>if they fall</u>, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, For he has no one to help him up.

Galatians 6:1 <u>Brethren</u>, <u>if a man is overtaken in any trespass</u>, <u>you who are spiritual restore such a</u> one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted.

Romans 12:10-11 <u>Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;</u>
