The Messenger

The Greek of the Septuagint uses the word <u>angelos</u> translated messenger

Haggai 1:13 Then Haggai, the LORD's messenger, spoke the LORD's message to the people, saying,"I am with you, says the LORD." NKJV

Malachi 2:7 "For the lips of a priest should keep knowledge, And people should seek the law from his mouth; For he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts. NKJV

Malachi 3:1 "Behold, <u>I send My messenger</u>, And <u>he will prepare the way before Me</u>. And the Lord, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, <u>Even the messenger of the covenant</u>, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming," Says the LORD of hosts. NKJV

MESSENGER---1. angelos NT:32, "a messenger, an angel, one sent," is translated "messenger," of John the Baptist, Matt 11:10; Mark 1:2; Luke 7:27; in the plural, of John's "messengers," 7:24; (Vine's Expository Dictionary of Biblical Words, Copyright (c)1985, Thomas Nelson Publishers)

The Evangelist

EVANGELIST—euangelistes NT:2099, lit., "a messenger of good" (eu, "well," angelos, "a messenger"), denotes a "preacher of the gospel," Acts 21:8; Eph 4:11, which makes clear the distinctiveness of the function in the churches; 2 Tim 4:5. Cf. euangelizo, "to proclaim glad tidings," and euangelion, "good news, gospel." (from Vine's Expository Dictionary of Biblical Words, Copyright (c)1985, Thomas Nelson Publishers)

Acts 21:8 On the next day we who were Paul's companions departed and <u>came to Caesarea</u>, and <u>entered the house of Philip the evangelist</u>, who was one of the seven, and stayed with him. NKJV

Ephesians 4:11 And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, NKJV

2 Timothy 4:5 But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry NKJV

Colossians 4:16-17 Now when this epistle is read among you, see that it is read also in the church of the Laodiceans, and that you likewise read the epistle from Laodicea. 17 And say to Archippus, "Take heed to the ministry which you have received in the Lord, that you may fulfill it." NKJV

The Angelos Of The Seven Churches

Revelation 1:20 The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches. NKJV

Revelation 2:1 "To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, 'These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: NKJV

Revelation 2:7 "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. NKJV
