Propaganda And Persuasion

Propaganda-Mass "suggestion" or influence through the manipulation of symbols and the psychology of the individual. Propaganda is the communication of a point of view with the ultimate goal of having the recipient of the appeal come to "voluntarily" accept this position as if it were his or her own."

I. Make Yourself Likable And Tell Them What They Want To Hear

"making yourself likeable: Say what the audience thinks, make others feel comfortable, and control the atmosphere (the situation) for your best advantage."

II. The Use Of Labels

"labels can be used to pre-persuade."..."One serious consequence is that out-group members are dehumanized; they are represented in our mind by a simple, often derogatory label."

III. Following The Crowd
