PERFECT 1. teleios NT:5049 signifies "having reached its end" (telos), "finished, complete perfect."

Colossians 2:9 For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; 10 and <u>you are complete in Him</u>, who is the head of all principality and power.

Colossians 1:28 Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus. NKJV

II. Becoming Complete Through The Complete Word Of God

NKJV

- 1 John 2:5 <u>But whoever keeps His word</u>, <u>truly the love of God is perfected in him</u>. By this we know that we are in Him. NKJV
- 1 John 2:5 <u>But if anyone obeys his word</u>, <u>God's love is truly made complete in him</u>. This is how we know we are in him: NIV
- 1 John 4:12 No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us. NIV
