Hebrews 3:13 <u>but exhort one another daily</u>, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. (NKJV)

Galatians 6:10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith. (NKJV)

IV. YOUR WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN

Luke 9:23 Then He said to [them] all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. (NKJV)

Acts 17:11 These were more fair-minded than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness, and <u>searched the Scriptures daily [to find out] whether these things were so.</u> (NKJV)

V. GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD

Ecclesiastes 2:24 Nothing [is] better for a man [than] that he should <u>eat and drink</u>, and [that] his soul should enjoy good in his labor. This also, I saw, was from the hand of God.

2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: <u>If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat</u>. (NKJV)

VL AND FORGIVE US OUR DEBTS

1 John 2:1 My little children, these things I write to you, so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (NKJV)

VII. AS WE FORGIVE OUR DEBTORS

Ephesians 4:26 "Be angry, and do not sin": do not let the sun go down on your wrath,

Matthew 5:23-24 "Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that your brother has something against you, "leave your gift there before the altar, and go your way. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

VIII. AND DO NOT LEAD US INTO TEMPTATION

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God [is] faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear [it.]

IX. BUT DELIVER US FROM THE EVIL ONE

Ephesians 6:11-13 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual [hosts] of wickedness in the heavenly [places.] Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

X. FOR YOURS IS THE KINGDOM AND THE POWER AND THE GLORY FOREVER

Revelation 4:11 "You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created." (NKJV)
