Isaiah 49:6 You should be My Servant

Isaiah 50:10 Who obeys the voice of His Servant?

Isaiah 52:13-15 Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently

Isaiah 53:11 By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.

Isaiah 42:1-7 "Behold! My Servant My Elect One in whom My soul delights!

Matthew 3:17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."

• Isaiah 42:1 "Behold! My Servant I have put My Spirit upon Him;

Isaiah 11:1-2 There shall come forth a Rod from the stem of Jesse, And a Branch shall grow out of his roots. 2 The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.

2 Corinthians 6:2 For He says: "In an acceptable time I have heard you, And in the day of salvation I have helped you." Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.

Isaiah 42:6-7 As a light to the Gentiles, 7 To open blind eyes,

Matthew 21:14 Then the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed them.

Acts 26:17-18 I will deliver you from the Jewish people, as well as from the Gentiles, to whom I now send you. 18 to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'

- Isaiah 42:7 To bring out prisoners from the prison.
  - Those who sit in darkness from the prison house.

Isaiah 49:9 That You may say to the prisoners, 'Go forth,' To those who are in darkness, 'Show yourselves.'

Isaiah 61:1 "The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the LORD has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives. And the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

Ephesians 4:8-10 Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men." 9(Now this, "He ascended" — what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? 10 He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)

Hebrews 2:14-16 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Revelation 1:18 I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death.

# Isaiah 49:5 Who formed Me from the womb to be His Servant

Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will evershadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

Matthew 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, <u>glorified His Servant</u> <u>Jesus</u>, whom you delivered up and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let Him go.

Acts 3:26 To you first, God, <u>having raised up His Servant Jesus</u>, sent Him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from your iniquities."

Acts 4:27-30 27 "For truly against Your hely Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together

30 by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus."

### Isaiah 49:5 To Bring Jacob Back To Him

Isaiah 49:5-9 To bring Jacob back to Him, So that Israel is gathered to Him (For I shall be glorious in the eyes of the LORD, And My God shall be My strength), 6 Indeed He says, is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob, And to restore the preserved ones of Israel;

Isaiah 11:11-12 It shall come to pass in that day That the Lord shall set His hand again the second time To recover the remnant of His people who are left, From Assyria and Egypt, From Pathros and Cush, From Elam and Shinar, From Hamath and the islands of the sea. 12 He will set up a banner for the nations, And will assemble the outcasts of Israel, And gather together the dispersed of Judah From the four corners of the earth.

John 12:32 And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself."

Romans 9:27 <u>Isaiah also cries out concerning Israel</u>: "Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, <u>The remnant will be saved</u>.

Romans 11:5 Even so then, at this present time there is a remnant according to the election of grace.

James 1:1 James, a bondservant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad: Greetings.

# Isaiah 49:6 That You Should Be My Salvation To The Ends Of The Earth

Isaiah 49:6 I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, That You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.'

Matthew 28:18-19 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit;

Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Acts 13:47 For so the Lord has commanded us: 'I have set you as a light to the Gentiles, That you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth.'"

# Isaiah 49:7 To Him Whom Man Despises

Isaiah 49:7 Thus says the LORD, The Redeemer of Israel, their Holy One, To Him whom man despises, To Him whom the nation abhors,

Isaiah 53:3 He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

John 1:11 He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

John 19:6 Therefore, when the chief priests and officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!"

# Isaiah 49:7 The Holy One of Israel; And He has chosen You."

Matthew 12:14-18 Then the Pharisees went out and plotted against Him, how they might destroy Him. 15 But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all. 16 Yet He warned them not to make Him known, 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: 18 "Behold! My Servant whom I have chosen, My Beloved in whom My soul is well pleased! I will put My Spirit upon Him, And He will declare justice to the Gentiles.

Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

Mark 1:24 saying, "Let us alone! What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? I know who You are — the Holy One of God!"

Acts 2:27 For You will not leave my soul in Hades, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.

# Isaiah 50:6 I gave My back to those who struck Me,

Isaiah 52:14 Just as many were astonished at you, So His visage was marred more than any man, And His form more than the sons of men;

Isaiah 53:5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

John 19:1 So then Pilate took Jesus and scourged Him.

Isaiah 50:6 I Did Not Hide My Face From Shame And Spitting

Isaiah 50:6 And My cheeks to those who plucked out the beard; I did not hide My face from shame and spitting.

Mark 14:65 Then some began to spit on Him, and to blindfold Him, and to beat Him, and to say to Him, "Prophesy!" And the officers struck Him with the palms of their hands.

Matthew 27:30 Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.

- Isaiah 52:13 Behold, My Servant shall deal prudently;

  He shall be exalted and extelled and be very high.
- Isaiah 53:12 Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.

Acts 5:31 <u>Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior</u>, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.

Philippians 2:9-11 Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Isaiah 45:22-23 "Look to Me, and be saved, All you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other. 23 I have sworn by Myself; The word has gone out of My mouth in righteousness, And shall not return, That to Me every knee shall bow, Every tongue shall take an oath.

#### The Servant Of Isaiah 53

### Who Has Believed Our Report?

Isaiah 53:1 Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?

John 12:37-38 But although He had done so many signs before them, they did not believe in Him, 38 that the word of Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spoke: "Lord, who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed?"

Romans 10:16-17 <u>But they have not all obeyed the gospel</u>. For Isaiah says, "<u>LORD</u>, who has believed our report?" 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

### He Is Despised And Rejected By Men

Isaiah 53:3 <u>He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief.</u> And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.

John 1:11 He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

#### He Has Born Our Griefs And Carried Our Sorrows

Isaiah 53:4 <u>Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows</u>; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.

Matthew 8:16-17 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses."

Luke 19:41 Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it,

# He Was Wounded For Our Transgressions

Isaiah 53:5 But <u>He was wounded for our transgressions</u>, <u>He was bruised for our iniquities</u>; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And <u>by His stripes we are healed</u>.

Matthew 26:67-68 Then they spat in His face and <u>beat Him</u>; and <u>others struck Him</u> with the palms of their hands, 68 saying, "Prophesy to us, Christ! Who is the one who struck You?"

Matthew 27:30 Then they spat on Him, and took the reed and struck Him on the head.

Matthew 27:26 Then he released Barabbas to them; and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered Him to be crucified.

# The Lord Laid On Him The Iniquity Of Us All

Isaiah 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

1 Peter 2:24-25 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness — by whose stripes you were healed.
25 For you were like sheep going astray, but have now returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls

2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

1 John 2:2 And <u>He Himself is the propitiation for our sins</u>, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

# He Opened Not His Mouth

Isaiah 53:7 <u>He was oppressed and He was afflicted</u>, <u>Yet He opened not His mouth</u>; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, <u>So He opened not His mouth</u>.

Matthew 26:62-63 And the high priest arose and said to Him, "<u>Do You answer nothing</u>? What is it these men testify against You?" 63 <u>But Jesus kept silent</u>. And the high priest answered and said to Him, "I put You under oath by the living God: Tell us if You are the Christ, the Son of God!"

Mark 15:3-5 And the chief priests accused Him of many things, but He answered nothing. 4 Then Pilate asked Him again, saying, "Do You answer nothing? See how many things they testify against You!" 5 But Jesus still answered nothing, so that Pilate marveled.

# He Was Taken From Prison And From Judgment

Isaiah 53:8 <u>He was taken from prison and from judgment</u>, And who will declare His generation? <u>For He was cut off from the land of the living</u>; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

John 18:38 Pilate said to Him, "What is truth?" And when he had said this, he went out again to the Jews, and said to them, "I find no fault in Him at all.

John 19:4 Pilate then went out again, and said to them, "Behold, I am bringing Him out to you, that you may know that <u>I find no fault in Him.</u>"

John 19:12 From then on Pilate sought to release Him, but the Jews cried out, saying, "If you let this Man go, you are not Caesar's friend. Whoever makes himself a king speaks against Caesar."

John 19:16 Then he delivered Him to them to be crucified. Then they took Jesus and led Him away.

They Made His Grave With The Wicked—But With The Rich At His Death

Isaiah 53:9 And they made His grave with the wicked — But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was any deceit in His mouth.

Matthew 27:57-60 Now when evening had come, there came a rich man from Arimathea, named Joseph, who himself had also become a disciple of Jesus. 58 This man went to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus. Then Pilate commanded the body to be given to him. 59 When Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, 60 and laid it in his new tomb which he had hewn out of the rock; and he rolled a large stone against the door of the tomb, and departed.

# He Shall See His Seed, He Shall Prolong His Days

Isaiah 53:10 Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, <u>He shall see His seed</u>, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.

Galatians 3:29 And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

Ephesians 1:19-23 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power 20 which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, 21 far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. 22 And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

#### I Will Divide Him A Portion With The Great

Isaiah 53:12 Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.

Matthew 28:18-20 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

# He Shall Divide The Spoil With The Strong

Romans 8:16-17 The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, 17 and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also be glorified together.

Ephesians 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,

1 Peter 1:3-4 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,

# Because He Poured Out His Soul Unto Death

Matthew 27:50 And Jesus cried out again with a loud voice, and vielded up His spirit

And He Was Numbered With The Transgressors

Matthew 27:38 Then two robbers were crucified with Him, one on the right and another on the left.

# And He Made Intercession For The Transgressors

Romans 8:34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and <u>furthermore is</u> also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

Hebrews 7:25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

Isaiah 53:8 For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

Isaiah 53:10 When You make His soul an offering for sin,

Isaiah 53:11 For He shall bear their iniquities.
