A Woman Who Fears The Lord

Genesis 2:18 And the LORD God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him."

Genesis 2:22-23 Then the rib which the LORD God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man. 23 And Adam said: "This is now bone of my bones And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man."

I. The Beauty Of Woman

Ecclesiastes 3:11 He has made everything beautiful in its time.

Ester 2:7 And Mordecai had brought up Hadassah, that is, Esther, his uncle's daughter, for she had neither father nor mother. The young woman was lovely and beautiful.

Proverbs 6:25 Do not lust after her beauty in your heart, Nor let her allure you with her eyelids.

1 Corinthians 11:15 But if a woman has long hair, it is a glory to her; for her hair is given to her for a covering.

II. The True Beauty Of A Woman

Proverbs 31:30-31 Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised. 31 Give her of the fruit of her hands, And let her own works praise her in the gates.

1 Peter 3:3-4 <u>Do not let your adornment be merely outward</u> — arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on fine apparel — 4 <u>rather let it be the hidden person of the heart</u>, <u>with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit</u>, <u>which is very precious in the sight of God</u>.

Proverbs 31:26 She opens her mouth with wisdom, And on her tongue is the law of kindness.

2 Corinthians 4:16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day.

Proverbs 16:31 The silver-haired head is a crown of glory, If it is found in the way of righteousness.

III. The Humility Of The Woman Who Fears The Lord

Philippians 2:5-8 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

Colossians 3:18 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

Ephesians 5:22-24 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. 24 Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.

IV. The Service Of A Woman Who Fears The Lord

Mark 10:45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Titus 2:3-5 the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things — 4 that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, 5 to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.

Proverbs 31:27 She watches over the ways of her household, And does not eat the bread of idleness.

Proverbs 31:14-15 She is like the merchant ships, She brings her food from afar. 15 She also rises while it is yet night, And provides food for her household, And a portion for her maidservants.

Proverbs 31:20 She extends her hand to the poor, Yes, she reaches out her hands to the needy.

V. The Courage Of A Woman Who Fears The Lord

1 Corinthians 16:13 Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong.

Proverbs 31:25 Strength and honor are her clothing; She shall rejoice in time to come.

Proverbs 31:21 She is not afraid of snow for her household, For all her household is clothed with scarlet.

- 1 Peter 3:5-6 For in this manner, in former times, the holy women who trusted in God also adorned themselves, being submissive to their own husbands, 6 as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, whose daughters you are if you do good and are not afraid with any terror.
- 1 Peter 3:14-15 But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you are blessed. "And do not be afraid of their threats, nor be troubled." 15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;
- 1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.
