Becoming And Maintaining Our Sanctification From The World

<u>Sanctify</u>-1. To make, render, or declare sacred or holy. 2. To separate from things profane and dedicate to God. (<u>Thayer's Greek Lexicon</u>, p.6)

<u>Secularization</u>-To render secular; convert from sacred to secular use; make worldly. (<u>Britannica</u> <u>Dictionary</u>, p. 1153)

I. The Sacrifice God Gave For Us To Be Able To Be Sanctified

Hebrews 10:10 By that will we have been <u>sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ</u> once for all.

Hebrews 13:12 Therefore Jesus also, that He might <u>sanctify the people with His own blood</u>, suffered outside the gate.

Hebrews 10:29 Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?

John 17:14-18 I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them because they are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. 15 I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. 16 They are not of the world, just as I am not of the world. 17 Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth.

John 17:19 And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth.

II. Attaining Sanctification By Obeying The Gospel

Acts 26:18 to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.'

Romans 12:1-2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you <u>present your bodies</u> a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.2 And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

2 Corinthians 6:17 Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you."

Ephesians 5:25-26 Husbands, love your wives, just as <u>Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for</u> <u>her</u>, 26 <u>that He might sanctify and cleanse her</u> <u>with the washing of water by the word</u>,

III. Maintaining Our Sanctification In A Wicked World

1 Peter 1:15-16 but as He who called you is holy, <u>you also be holy in all your conduct</u>, 16 because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

James 4:4 Adulterers and adulteresses! <u>Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God</u>? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

- 2 Timothy 2:19-21 Nevertheless the solid foundation of God stands, having this seal: "The Lord knows those who are His," and, "Let everyone who names the name of Christ depart from iniquity." 20 But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay, some for honor and some for dishonor. 21 Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.
- 1 Thessalonians 4:3-4 For this is the will of God, <u>your sanctification</u>: that you should abstain from sexual immorality; 4 that each of you should <u>know how to possess his own vessel in sanctification and honor</u>,
