## Worship-The Expressions Of Our Heart Toward God

Revelation 4:10 the twenty-four elders <u>fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever</u>, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: 11 "<u>You are worthy</u>, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created."

1 Corinthians 13:13 And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

## I. Worship The Expression Of Our Faith

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Matthew 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

1 Corinthians 11:24-26 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." 25 In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me." 26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

Ephesians 5:19 speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord,

James 1:7 But <u>let him ask in faith, with no doubting</u>, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.

Ephesians 3:20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,

2 Corinthians 9:7-8 So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. 8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.

## II. Worship The Expression Of Our Hope

Psalm 42:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him For the help of His countenance.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Matthews 6:8 "Therefore do not be like them. For your Father knows the things you have need of before you ask Him.

1 Peter 5:7 casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

Philippians 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

1 Corinthians 11:26 For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.

## III. Worship The Expression Of Our Love

1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.

1 John 4:19 We love Him because He first loved us.

James 1:17-18 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.

Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him <u>let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.</u>

Psalm 13:6 I will sing to the LORD, Because He has dealt bountifully with me.

Luke 7:47 Therefore I say to you, her sins, which are many, are forgiven, for she loved much. But to whom little is forgiven, the same loves little."

Psalm 51:14 <u>Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God</u>, The God of my salvation, <u>And my tongue shall sing aloud of Your righteousness</u>.

Psalm 71:23 My lips shall greatly rejoice when I sing to You, And my soul, which You have redeemed.

Psalm 96:2 Sing to the LORD, bless His name; Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.

Hebrews 2:12 saying: "I will declare Your name to My brethren; <u>In the midst of the assembly I will sing praise to You</u>."
