I. The Attack Of Satan When You Are Alone

Matthew 4:1-3 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry. Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread.

Mark 14:50 Then they all forsook Him and fled.

2 Samuel 11:1 It happened in the spring of the year, at the time when kings go out to battle, that <u>David sent Joab and his servants with him</u>, and all <u>Israel</u>; and they destroyed the people of Ammon and besieged Rabbah. <u>But David remained</u> at Jerusalem.

Luke 15:13 And not many days after, the younger son gathered all together, journeyed to a far country, and there wasted his possessions with prodigal living.

Psalms 6:6 I am weary with my groaning; All night I make my bed swim; I drench my couch with my tears.

Romans 11:3 "LORD, they have killed Your prophets and torn down Your altars, and <u>I</u> alone am left, and they seek my life"?

Psalm 25:16 Turn to me and be gracious to me, For I am lonely and afflicted.
