Being Transformed Into The Image Of Christ

Romans 12:1-2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you <u>present your bodies</u> a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And <u>do not be</u> conformed to this world, <u>but be transformed by the renewing of your mind</u>, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Romans 8:29 <u>For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son,</u> that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Colossians 3:9-11 Do not lie to one another, since you have <u>put off the old man with his deeds</u>, 10 and <u>have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him</u>,

I. Being Transformed Into The Humility Of Christ

Colossians 3:12 Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, <u>put on</u> tender mercies, kindness, <u>humility</u>, meekness, longsuffering;

Philippians 2:3-8 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. 5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

1 Peter 5:6 Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,

II. Being Transformed Into The Holiness Of Christ

1 Peter 1:13-16 <u>Therefore gird up the loins of your mind</u>, <u>be sober</u>, and rest your hope fully upon the grace that is to be brought to you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; 14 as obedient children, <u>not conforming yourselves to the former lusts</u>, as in your ignorance; 15 but <u>as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct</u>, 16 because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

Romans 13:12-14 Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy 13 The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light. 14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

Ephesians 4:23 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind,24 and that you <u>put on the new man which</u> was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

2 Corinthians 6:17 Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you."

III. Being Transformed Into The Meekness And Strength Of Christ

1 Peter 2:19-24 For this is commendable, if because of conscience toward God one endures grief, suffering wrongfully.20 For what credit is it if, when you are beaten for your faults, you take it patiently? But when you do good and suffer, if you take it patiently, this is commendable before God.21 For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: 22 "Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth"; 23 who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously;

IV. Being Transformed Into The Love Of Christ

Colossians 3:12-15 <u>Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on</u> tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering;13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.14 <u>But above all</u> these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

1 John 3:16-18 By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.17 But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him? 18 My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.
