I. The Heart That Desires To Be A Mother

Genesis 30:1 Now when Rachel saw that she bore Jacob no children, Rachel envied her sister, and said to Jacob, "Give me children, or else I die!"

1 Samuel 1:10-11 And she was in bitterness of soul, and prayed to the LORD and wept in anguish.

Genesis 25:21 Now <u>Isaac pleaded with the LORD for his wife</u>, <u>because she was barren</u>; and the LORD granted his plea, and Rebekah his wife conceived.

Psalm 113:9 He grants the barren woman a home, Like a joyful mother of children. Praise the LORD!

II. The Heart That Will Endure The Pain To Know The Joy

Genesis 25:22 <u>But the children struggled together within her</u>; and she said, "If all is well, why am I like this?" So she went to inquire of the LORD.

Micah 4:10 Be in pain, and labor to bring forth, O daughter of Zion, Like a woman in birth pangs.

Revelation 12:2 Then being with child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth.

John 16:21 A woman, when she is in labor, has sorrow because her hour has come; but as soon as she has given birth to the child, she no longer remembers the anguish, for joy that a human being has been born into the world.

Luke 1:14 And you will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice at his birth.

III. A Heart Filled With Love For Her Children

Proverbs 31:26 She opens her mouth with wisdom, And on her tongue is the law of kindness.

Isaiah 66:13 As one whom his mother comforts, So I will comfort you; And you shall be comforted in Jerusalem."

Psalm 131:2 Surely <u>I have calmed and quieted my soul</u>, <u>Like a weaned child with his mother</u>; <u>Like a weaned child is my soul within me</u>.

IV. A Heart Filled With God For Her Children

Proverbs 31:30 <u>Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing</u>, <u>But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised</u>.

1 Samuel 1:11 Then she made a vow and said, "O LORD of hosts, if You will indeed look on the affliction of Your maidservant and remember me, and not forget Your maidservant, <u>but will give Your maidservant a male child, then I will give him to the LORD all the days of his life</u>, and no razor shall come upon his head."

Proverbs 31:25-26 <u>Strength and honor are her clothing</u>; She shall rejoice in time to come. 26 <u>She opens her mouth with wisdom</u>, And on her tongue is the law of kindness.

Proverbs 1:8-9 My son, hear the instruction of your father, And do not forsake the law of your mother; 9 For they will be a graceful ornament on your head, And chains about your neck.

2 Timothy 1:5 when I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also.
