I. A Desire For Peace From Both Of The Estranged Parties

Proverbs 26:17 He who passes by and meddles in a quarrel not his own is like one who takes a dog by the ears.

Psalm 120:7 I am for peace; But when I speak, they are for war.

Psalm 34:14 Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.

Psalm 133:1 Behold, how good and how pleasant it is For brethren to dwell together in unity!

II. <u>Humility</u>

Proverbs 13:10 By pride comes nothing but strife, But with the well-advised is wisdom

Proverbs 11:2 When pride comes, then comes shame; But with the humble is wisdom.

Matthew 5:23-25 Therefore if you bring your gift to the altar, and there remember that <u>your brother has something against you.</u>24 leave your gift there before the altar, and <u>go your way.</u>

First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift.

III. Meaningful Respectful Communication

James 1:19-20 So then, my beloved brethren, let every man <u>be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath</u>;20 for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

Proverbs 18:13 He who answers a matter before he hears it, it is folly and shame to him.

Proverbs 15:28 The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours forth evil.

Proverbs 15:1 A soft answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger.

Proverbs 15:18 A hot-tempered man stirs up strife, But the slow to anger calms a dispute.

IV. A Willingness To Face The Truth

V. A Willingness To Change Where You Are Wrong
