The Uns Of Romans 1:31 Part 2-Untrustworthy Or Covenant-breakers

Romans 1:31 undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful; NKJV

Romans 1:31 Without understanding, covenant-breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: KJV

Genesis 21:31-32 Therefore he called that place Beersheba, because the two of them swore an oath there. 32 Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba.

Ezekiel 17:18 Since he despised the oath by breaking the covenant, and in fact gave his hand and still did all these things, he shall not escape.'"

I. Covenant-breakers In Business

1 Corinthians 4:2 Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful

Luke 16:10-11 He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much. 11 Therefore if you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches?

Proverbs 22:26-27 Do not be one of those who shakes hands in a pledge, One of those who is surety for debts; 27 If you have nothing with which to pay, Why should he take away your bed from under you?

Ecclesiastes 5:5 Better not to vow than to vow and not pay.

Proverbs 25:19 Confidence in an unfaithful man in time of trouble Is like a bad tooth and a foot out of joint.

2 Corinthians 7:16 Therefore I rejoice that I have confidence in you in everything.

II. Covenant-breakers In Marriage

Malachi 2:14-16 Yet you say, "For what reason?" <u>Because the LORD has been witness Between you and the wife of your youth, With whom you have dealt treacherously;</u> Yet she is your companion And <u>your wife by covenant</u>. 15 But did He not make them one, Having a remnant of the Spirit? And why one? He seeks godly offspring. Therefore take heed to your spirit, And <u>let none deal treacherously with the wife of his youth</u>. 16 "For the LORD God of Israel says That He hates <u>divorce</u>, For it covers one's garment with violence," Says the LORD of hosts. "Therefore take heed to your spirit, That you do not deal treacherously."

Matthew 19:6 So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate."

1 Corinthians 7:39 A wife is bound by law as long as her husband lives; but if her husband dies, she is at liberty to be married to whom she wishes, only in the Lord.

1 Corinthians 7:10-11 Now to the married I command, yet not I but the Lord: A wife is not to depart from her husband. 11 But even if she does depart, let her remain unmarried or be reconciled to her husband. And a husband is not to divorce his wife.

Mark 10:11-12 So He said to them, "Whoever divorces his wife and marries another commits adultery against her. 12 And if a woman divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery."

Matthew 19:9 And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery."

Proverbs 31:11-12 The heart of her husband safely trusts her; So he will have no lack of gain. 12 She does him good and not evil All the days of her life.

III. Covenant-breakers With God

Numbers 30:2 If a man makes a vow to the LORD, or swears an oath to bind himself by some agreement, he shall not break his word; he shall do according to all that proceeds out of his mouth.

Matthew 22:21 They said to Him, "Caesar's." And He said to them, "Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's."

Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you <u>present your bodies</u> a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

Hebrews 10:26-30 For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, 27 but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries. 28 Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. 29 Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace?

Matthew 25:21 His lord said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord.'
