Jeremiah 17:10 <u>I, the LORD</u>, search the heart, I test the mind, Even to give every man according to his ways, According to the fruit of his doings.

I. The Wrong Motives For Serving God

A. What Will You Give Me

John 6:26-27 Jesus answered them and said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled. 27 Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him.

Luke 17:12-19 Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. 13 And they lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" 14 So when He saw them, He said to them, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And so it was that as they went, they were cleansed. 15 And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, 16 and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan. 17 So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? 18 Were there not any found who returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" 19 And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. Your faith has made you well."

2 Thessalonians 3:10 For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: <u>If</u> anyone will not work, neither shall he eat.

B. To Please People

2 Corinthians 7:10 For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.

- 1 Corinthians 13:3 And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.
- 1 Peter 4:9 Be hospitable to one another without grumbling.

1 Thessalonians 1:3 remembering without ceasing <u>your work of faith, labor of love,</u> and <u>patience of hope</u> in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father,

Hebrews 11:6 <u>But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is</u>, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Acts 16:31 So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household."

2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Romans 8:24-25 For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees? 25 But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.

Titus 1:2 in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began,

Hebrews 3:6 but Christ as a Son over His own house, whose house we are <u>if we hold</u> fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end.

Hebrews 11:7 By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.
