## Do Not Fret Because Of Evildoers

Psalms 37:1-2 <u>Do not fret because of evildoers, Nor be envious of the workers of iniquity</u>. 2 For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, And wither as the green herb.

Psalms 37:7-8 Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, Because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass. 8 Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; Do not fret—it only causes harm.

Psalms 131:1 Lord, my heart is not haughty, Nor my eyes lofty. Neither do I concern myself with great matters, Nor with things too profound for me.

## I. Do Not Fret, Trust In The Lord

Psalms 37:3 <u>Trust in the Lord</u>, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.

Psalms 131:3 O Israel, hope in the Lord From this time forth and forever.

Psalms 37:9-10 For evildoers shall be cut off; But those who wait on the Lord, They shall inherit the earth. 10 For yet a little while and the wicked shall be no more; Indeed, you will look carefully for his place, But it shall be no more.

Psalms 37:35-36 I have seen the wicked in great power, And spreading himself like a native green tree. 36 Yet he passed away, and behold, he was no more; Indeed I sought him, but he could not be found.

Psalms 37:23-25 The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, And He delights in his way. 24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; For the Lord upholds him with His hand. 25 I have been young, and now am old; Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, Nor his descendants begging bread.

Psalms 37:39-40 <u>But the salvation of the righteous is from the Lord; He is their strength in the time of trouble.</u> 40 And the Lord shall help them and deliver them; He shall deliver them from the wicked, <u>And save them, Because they trust in Him.</u>

## II. Do Not Fret, Commit Your Way To The Lord

Psalms 37:5-6 Commit your way to the Lord, <u>Trust also in Him</u>, And He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, And your justice as the noonday.

Philippians 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; 7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

2 Timothy 1:12 For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day.

## III. Do Not Fret, Rest In The Lord

Psalms 37:7 Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, Because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass.

Psalms 131:2 <u>Surely I have calmed and quieted my soul</u>, Like a weaned child with his mother; Like a weaned child is my soul within me.

Psalms 37:37 Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; For the future of that man is peace.

Isaiah 26:3 You will keep him in perfect peace, Whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trusts in You.
