

Walk As He Walked

1 John 2:6 He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

Colossians 2:6 As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him,

I. Walking In The Obedience Of Jesus

Philippians 2:5-8 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

John 6:38 For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.

II. Walking In The Meekness Of Jesus

1 Peter 2:21-23 For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: 22 "Who committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth"; 23 who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously;

Matthew 27:12-14 And while He was being accused by the chief priests and elders, He answered nothing. 13 Then Pilate said to Him, "Do You not hear how many things they testify against You?" 14 But He answered him not one word, so that the governor marveled greatly.

III. Walking In The Humility Of Jesus

John 13:5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.

John 13:15 For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.

IV. Walking In The Courage Of Jesus

John 10:17-18 "Therefore My Father loves Me, because I lay down My life that I may take it again. 18 No one takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This command I have received from My Father."

V. Walking In The Mercy Of Jesus

Colossians 3:13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.

Luke 23:34 Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do."

VI. Walking In The Love Of Jesus

1 John 3:16 By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren.

John 13:34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.
