I. God Has Heard My Voice And My Supplication

Psalms 116:1-2 Thanksgiving for Deliverance from Death I love the Lord, because He has heard My voice and my supplications. Because He has inclined His ear to me, Therefore I will call upon Him as long as I live.

The Pains Of Death Surrounded Me

Psalms 116:3-4 The pains of death surrounded me, And the pangs of Sheol laid hold of me; I found trouble and sorrow. Then I called upon the name of the Lord: "O Lord, I implore You, deliver my soul!"

The Lord Delivered My Soul From Death, From Tears, And Falling

Psalms 116:5-8 Gracious is the Lord, and righteous; Yes, our God is merciful. The Lord preserves the simple; I was brought low, and He saved me. Return to your rest, O my soul, For the Lord has dealt bountifully with you. For You have delivered my soul from death, My eyes from tears, And my feet from falling.

Philippians 1:23-25 " I am hard pressed between the two. My desire is to depart and be with Christ, for that is far better. But to remain in the flesh is more necessary on your account. Convinced of this, I know that I will remain and continue with you all, for your progress and joy in the faith,"

II. What Shall I Render To The Lord

Psalms 116:12 What shall I render to the Lord For all His benefits toward me?

III. I Will Walk Before The Lord

Psalms 116:9 I will walk before the Lord In the land of the living.

Genesis 17:1 When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless.

1 Kings 2:4 that the Lord may fulfill His word which He spoke concerning me, saying, 'If your sons take heed to their way, to walk before Me in truth with all their heart and with all their soul,' He said, 'you shall not lack a man on the throne of Israel.'

Ephesians 5:8-10 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light (for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), finding out what is acceptable to the Lord."

IV. I Will Take Up The Cup Of Salvation

Psalms 116:13 I will take up the cup of salvation, And call upon the name of the Lord.

Psalms 51:12-13 Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, And uphold me by Your generous Spirit. Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, And sinners shall be converted to You.

1 Chronicles 16:23 Sing to the Lord, all the earth; Proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day.

V. I Will Pay My Vows To The Lord

Psalms 116:16-18 O Lord, truly I am Your servant; I am Your servant, the son of Your maidservant; You have loosed my bonds. I will offer to You the sacrifice of thanksgiving, And will call upon the name of the Lord. I will pay my vows to the Lord Now in the presence of all His people,

Proverbs 20:25 " It is a snare for a man to devote rashly something as holy, And afterward to reconsider his vows."

Psalms 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass.

Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.

VI. I Will Offer To You The Sacrifice Of Thanksgiving

Psalms 116:17 I will offer to You the sacrifice of thanksgiving, And will call upon the name of the Lord.

Psalms 13:6 I will sing to the Lord, Because He has dealt bountifully with me.

Psalms 18:49 Therefore I will give thanks to You, O Lord, among the Gentiles, And sing praises to Your name.

Psalms 104:33 I will sing to the Lord as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have my being.
